- Completion of general education requirements
- One introductory-level psychology course (i.e. General Psychology) and a mathematics requirement of Intermediate Algebra or higher
- Online application

#### **Master's Degree Programs**

- Must hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution or the international equivalent
- Online application through PSYCAS (Application fee)
- Resume or CV
- Statement of purpose
- Letters of recommendation from three academic or professional references
- Official transcripts
- MS in Psychology applicants must complete these prerequisite courses:
  - Developmental Psychology
  - Physiological or Biological Psychology
  - Personality or Abnormal Psychology
  - Statistics

International applicants for all programs may have additional requirements.

#### Clinical Psychology Doctoral Programs

## PhD in Counselor Education and Supervision

- Students must reside in California within sufficient proximity to the University
- Must hold a master's degree in counseling
- Must have successfully completed masterslevel core curriculum aligned with CACREP curriculum standards as well as content in at least one CACREP-aligned specialty area.
